The Logo of the Salesians of Don Bosco is made up of two superimposed images: in the background a stylised “S” (Salesians) in white marked to the right and left by two cuttings between the hills (a road). The second image is in the centre of the globe: an arrow pointing upwards resting on three perpendicular legs on top of which are three closed circles making a stylised image of three people: the first of these in the middle and taller (the Salesian) appears as if embracing the side figures (the young). The three stylised figures can also be viewed as an arrow pointing upwards (education / formation) or simply as a dwelling (Salesian house) with three pillars holding it up (reason, religion, loving kindness).



The coat of arms of the Salesian Congregation shows the shining star, the large anchor, the heart on fire symbolizing faith, hope and charity; the figure of St. Francis de Sales recalling the Patron of the Society; the small wood in the lower part reminds us of the Founder (Bosco) the high mountains signify the heights of perfection towards which members strive; the interwoven palm and laurel that enfold the shield either side are emblematic of the prize reserved for a sacrificial and virtuous life. The motto *Da mihi animas, caetera tolle* (give me souls, take the rest) expresses every Salesian's ideal.

200 Sena mit-Twelid ta' Dun Bosco

Dun Bosco twieled nhar is-16 ta' Awwissu 1815. Dan ifisser li tliet snin oħra il-Familja Salesjana tkun qiegħda tiċċelebra l-200 sena (biċentenarju) mit-twelid tal-Qaddis fundatur tagħha.

F'ħajtu Dun Bosco kien waqqaf il-Kongregazzjoni tal-Patrijiet Salesjani, dik tas-Sorijiet Uljed Marija Ġhajnuna tal-Insara, l-Għaqda tas-Salesjani Koperaturi u dik tad-Devoti ta' Marija Ġhajnuna tal-Insara. Ma' dawn imbagħad, biż-żmien, żdiedu l-Għaqda tal-*Past Pupils*, tan-Nisa Volontarji ta' Dun Bosco u xi 15-il Istitut ta' Sorijiet jew Għaqdiet Lajċi mwaqqfa minn Salesjani madwar id-dinja, li kollha jimxu skont l-ispiritu u l-karizma ta' San Ġwann Bosco. Dawn kollha flimkien jiffurmaw il-Familja Salesjana.

Min- nhar is-16 ta' Awissu tal-2011 inbeda proċess ta' thejijja għaċ-ċelebrazzjoni tal-biċentenarju mit-twelid tal-Qaddis tagħna (1815 - 2015). Dakinhar, ir-Rettur Maġġur, Dun Pascual Chavez, flimkien mas-Superjuri tal-Kapitlu Ġenerali tas-Salesjani, qaddes quddies solenni fil-bażilika Salesjana li hemm f' Colle Don Bosco. Proprju fuq din l-għolja ġewwa razzett qrib ir-

raħal ta' Becchi, mhux bogħod minn Castelnuovo (Asti), kien twieled iċ-ċkejken Ġwanni Melchior minn Francesco Bosco u Margherita Occhiena.

Il-Familja Salesjana, mela, għandha quddiemha 3 snin ta' thejijja li matulhom aħna lkoll mistiedna niflu u nsiru nafu l-istorja ta' ħajjet il-qaddis (2011-2012) biex imbagħad nistudjaw il-**metodu ta' edukazzjoni** u formazzjoni li kien jużat maż-żgħażaġh (2012-2013) u naslu biex nifhmu xi ftit aktar l-**ispiritwalità** tiegħu (2013-2014). L-aħħar sena (2014-2015) tkun sena ta' ċelebrazzjonijiet mad-dinja kollha Salesjana.

Minħabba dan, matul dis-sena, *Hajja Salesjana* ser tippubblika l-ħajja ta' Dun Bosco f'ħames partijiet. Is-sena ta' wara tippubblika ħames artikli qosra fuq il-pedagoġija tiegħu sabiex matul it-tielet sena jkollna kitba fuq l-ispiritwalità tal-qaddis. L-aħħar sena tkun sena speċjali għalina hawn Malta, għaliex matulha nittamaw li jaslu r-relikwi ta' San Ġwann Bosco li bħalissa qiegħdin iduru mad-dinja, kif tistgħu taqraw f'kull harġa ta' *Hajja Salesjana*.

200 Years from the Birth of Don Bosco

Don Bosco was born on the 16th August 1815, which means that within 3 years, the Salesian Family will be celebrating the 200th year (bicentenary) of the birth of its holy founder.

During his life, Don Bosco founded the Congregation of the Salesian Fathers, the Institute of the Daughters of Mary Help of Christians, the Association of Salesian Cooperators and that of the Devotees of Mary Help of Christians. In following years, there were added to these the Association of Past Pupils, the female Volunteers of Don Bosco and about 15 other Institutes of Sisters or Lay Associations which all practice the charisma and live the spirit of St. John Bosco. Together, all these, form the Salesian Family.

Since 16th August 2011 there has begun a process of preparations for the celebration of this bicentenary of the birth of our Saint (1815 - 2015). On that day, the Rector Major Fr Pascual Chaves concelebrated Solemn Mass with the other Superiors of the General Council of the Salesians, in the Basilica of Don Bosco at Colle Don Bosco. It was in this locality, in a farm near the village of Becchi, not far from Castelnuovo (Asti), that the

little John Melchior was born to Francesco Bosco and Margherita Occhiena.

The Salesian Family has 3 years of preparation during which all are invited to read and come to know **the life** of Don Bosco (2011-2012) so that after that one may study the **method of education** which he applied to form the young (2012 - 2013). In the third year we will try to understand **his spirituality** (2013-2014). The last remaining year (2014-2015) will be the year of celebration all over the Salesian world.

Hajja Salesjana will be contributing to all this by publishing the life of Don Bosco in 5 parts during this year. The following year we will publish 5 short articles on the pedagogy of Don Bosco so as to arrive at the 3rd year of preparation with the publication of writings on the spirituality of the saint. The last year will be for us, here in Malta, a special year of celebration. During that year we are hoping to have among us the relics of St. John Bosco, which at the moment are going all around the Salesian world, as you may read in every issue of *Hajja Salesjana*.

Is-Sejha ta' Alla

L-Għażliet ta' Dun Bosco huma ddeterminati mis-sejha ta' Alla, is-sid tal-istorja

Fil-qalba tal-Antik Testament insibu s-sejha ta' Alla lil Mosè meta kellmu mill-ghollieq jaqbad. Il-Mulej qallu: "Jien harist u rajt it-tbatija tal-poplu tiegħi fl-Eġittu. U jiena smajt il-karba tagħhom minhabba l-argużini tagħhom u għaraft l-uġiġ tagħhom. Issa nżilt biex neħlishom...u biex intellagħhom minn dik l-art u nehodhom f'art tajba u wiegħsa..." (Es. 3, 7-8)

"Jiena rajt... jiena smajt... jiena għaraft... jiena neħlishom". Erba' kelmiet ta' mhabba ta' missier. Alla ma jabbandunax lil uliedu u hekk Dun Bosco

ġie msejjah biex iwassal l-imhabba tal-missier Alla fi żmienna.

Żmien ta' feriti.

Dun Bosco kien qiegħed jgħix fi żmien ta' tibdil mgħaġġel. Dan it-tibdil kien trawmatiku speċjalment fil-kamp soċjali u fil-Knisja. L-Illuminiżmu beda proċess ta' bidla mgħaġġla, li għab kważi fix-xejn lil hekk imsejha *societas cristiana*, permezz ta' ideoloġiji *anostici* u *anti-cristiani* fejn ir-raġuni/xjenza ħadet post il-fidi. Kien hemm ukoll sfiduċja min-naħa tal-klassi tal-ħaddiem, lejn

I-istituzzjonijiet tal-knisja. Fl-Italja, il-ġlied f'Ruma sabiex jitneħħa l-Istat Vatican, kien qiegħed iwegġa' qalb il-Kattolici. Il-persjoni tal-*intelligentsia* lajka u tal-klassi tal-*borghesia*, permezz tal-gazzetti u kotba li kienu jinflenzaw l-opinjoni pubblika u l-istil ta' ħajja, kienu qegħdin joħolqu ġenerazzjoni ġdida li, minħabba dan il-progress "mingħajr Alla" ħassitha mhawda waqt li bdiet taċċetta ideat u ħajja mbiegħda mill-fidi nisranija. Fl-istess waqt, bdew jidhru forom ġodda ta' faqar, miġjuba minn emigrazzjoni qawwija ġewwa u barra l-pajjiż, minn kulturi li bdew jgħibu, minn xogħol imħallas bil-ftit u minn thassir morali fost l-ifqar parti tal-poplu.

Isalva liż-żgħar

Kien eżatt dan il-kuntest storiku, dawn it-trawmi soċjali u dawn it-tensjonijiet li taw lil Dun Bosco l-okkazjoni li jisma' u jagħraf is-sejha ta' Alla. Waqt li oħrajn kienu jargumentaw, jikkundannaw, inewħu fuq il-kruha ta' żmienhom, huwa felah jara lil Alla preżenti u attiv fl-istorja tal-bniedem. Imhejji sew sabiex iħossu 'ragħaj' u msejjajh għas-salvazzjoni-speċjalment taż-żgħażaġh, - daħal għal dan ix-xogħol b'imħabba u b'għerf. Dejjem hass ruħu parti minn dak li kien qiegħed jiġri madwaru, lest li jagħti ħajtu għall-missjoni li kien iħoss li kellu jwettaq. Kien konvint li l-grazzja t'Alla hija aqwa minn kull tfixkil uman u li twiežen lil kull min jiħabat sabiex ixerred fil-qlub is-Saltna ta' Kristu.

Is-sitwazzjoni tat-tfal li ltaqa' magħhom f'Turin fis-snin 1840-1850, kif ukoll ġrajjet tal-knisja u tal-istat ta' dawk is-snin, urewh kif jadatta b'mod prattiku d-don tiegħu ta' edukatur, u ż-żelu tiegħu

għall-erwieh. It-talenti naturali tiegħu għenuh sabiex ikun attiv fit-tajjeb waqt li jindokra mil-ħazin.

Matul is-snin ta' wara, is-sitwazzjoni tbdiddet, u nqalghu problemi ġodda. Huwa, bil-għaqal tal-moħħ u d-dehen tal-ispirtu, għaraf jiftaħ orizzonti ġodda, jaħdem u jippjana, u jkabar l-opri tiegħu, filwaqt li jinvolvi fihom numru dejjem jikber ta' dixxipli, benefatturi u nies interessati fil-proġetti tiegħu. B'hekk, dawk it-tfal *faqar u abbandinati* li kien jaħdem għalihom saru dawk kollha li kellhom bżonn ta' għajnuna ekonomika, spiritwali, morali jew kulturali.

"Kollox niflah bis-saħħa ta' dak li jqawwini"

Dun Bosco għadu jgħodd għal żminijietna għaliex joffri ideat li jaqblu għall-htigijiet taż-żgħażaġh u ta' żmienna. Joffri wkoll tweġibiet effettivi għall-problemi ġodda, għax iħarsu 'l bogħod u huma mqanqla mill-imħabba t'Alla. Il-mod differenti kif jegħleb sfidi ġodda, htigijiet ġodda, u attacki ġodda ta' Satana, kollu ġej minn fidi soda, tama qawwija, għotja sħiħa lil Alla u lill-proxxmu u minn qalb hielsa minn kull irbit tad-dinja.

Hekk kiteb darba lil wieħed qassis li kien qata' qalbu, "Jekk hemm xogħol xi jsir, jiena mmut fuq il-kamp tax-xogħol bħal *suldat tajjeb ta' Kristu*. Forsi jiena tajjeb għall-ftit jew għal xejn? *Kollox niflah bis-saħħa ta' dak li jqawwini*. Hemm ix-xewk? B'dan ix-xewk mibdul fi fjur l-Anġli jinsgulek kuruna fis-sema. Iż-żminijiet diffiċli? Dejjem kienu, imma Alla qatt mhu sejjer ma jgħinekx: *Kristu lbieraħ u llum*. (25/10/1878, *Epistolario di S. Giovanni Bosco, III, 399*)

Coming to know Don Bosco in order to be faithful to him

The Rector Major presented the members of the General Council with the theme for the 2012 Strenna; it is in line with preparations for celebrating the bicentenary of Don Bosco's birth: "Let us make the young our life's mission by coming to know and imitate Don Bosco". With it comes a quote from John's Gospel (10:11) offering a biblical point of view:



"I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd lays down his life for his sheep".

In the introduction to his brief presentation, Fr Chávez states, "We need to study him, and through the events of his life we must come to know him as an educator and pastor, founder, guide, and legislator". In 2012, members of the Salesian Family will be called to discover and get to know the many-faceted figure of this saintly man from Turin. An awareness of Don Bosco's story has to begin with certain reference points: his pastoral charity; his hardship and suffering, and the many sacrifices which he made to achieve the ultimate purpose for the Salesian Family - that of being apostles of the young, both in ordinary settings and in poor and missionary areas.

To be faithful to Don Bosco means renewing our life's purpose, - the salvation of the young - the purpose for which he gave himself "until his dying breath." We meet the young in their various difficult circumstances: "poverty, child labour, sexual exploitation, lack of education and vocational training, lack of work and self-confidence, fear of the future, and the loss of

meaning of life". It is also a case of looking after the needs of addicts of technology, by sharing their life and interests, offering them help to acquire experience in forms of instant communication and social mobility, and the possibility of intellectual development and economic progress, also the opportunity to be pro-active through new technologies.

An indication of tasks that will flow from Strenna 2012 are: being with the young in places, circumstances and frontiers where they expect Salesian Family members to be. We also need to rediscover the "Memoirs of the Oratory of St Francis de Sales"*; written by Don Bosco. "So during this year (2012) let us be involved in getting to know this text, communicating its contents, disseminating it, and especially putting it into the hands of the young: it should also become an inspirational book for their vocational choice".

"Ġej fostkom bhala hukom fil-mixja tal-fidi wara Kristu u bhala Ragħaj Spiritwali." Hekk kitbilna, lilna l-Emigranti fl-Awstralja, l-Eċċellenza Tiegħu l-Isqof Mario Grech, ffit granet qabel beda żjara Pastoral fostna. U qalbna xeghlet għal dan il-messaġġ.



Issaħharna warajh biex nisimghu minn fomm u Kelma t'Alla. Attendejna kotrana kull funzjoni li saret u l-omeliji li l-Isqof għamlilna kienu qishom manna niezla mis-sema wara tant żmien ta' stennija biex naraw din iż-żjara ssir realtà.

L-ewwel quddiesa fil-programm kienet is-Sibt filgħodu, għar-residenti anzjani fil-Hostel St. Dominic, immexxi mis-sorijiet Dumnikani, ġewwa Blacktown. Hawnhekk l-Isqof xebbah il-miġja tiegħu fl-Awstralja bħal meta l-Arkanġlu Gabriel sellem lil Marija u qalilha "Il-Mulej mieghek". Hekk ukoll hu ried jurina li l-Mulej qiegħed magħna, l-emigranti fl-Awstralja.

Fil-ġhaxija mbagħad kien imiss li ssir quddiesa oħra fiċ-ċentru La Valette, fejn is-sala kienet maħnuqa minn emigranti kemm Maltin kif ukoll Għawdxin. Frank Zammit ta merħba lill-Isqof b'dawn il-kelmiet:

"Ilqa' dil-merħba o Ragħaj maħbub tagħna: Il-merħba mħeġġa hierġa minn qiegh qalbna; Għax ilha theġġeġ fina x-xewqa mqanqla Li narawk fostna u nisimghu kliemek".

L-ghada l-Hadd 2 t'Ottubru, morna bi ħgarna fil-Katidral ta' St. Mary ġol-belt ta' Sydney għal quddiesa pontifikali. Jikkonċelebraw mal-Isqof, kellna lil Fr. Tarcisio Micallef, Fr. Joe Barbara, Fr. Joe Cremona, Fr. Claude Borg u Fr. John Taliana li huma kollha membri tas-Socjeta Missjunarja ta' San Pawl. Magħhom kien hemm ukoll Fr. John Briffa sdb, l-Arcipriet Paolo Cardona, Fr. John Sultana, Fr. Eddie Zammit, Fr. John Vella ofm u Fr. Remiġ Galea ofm.

Fl-omelija, l-Isqof għamel riflessjoni dwar "l-ghalqa" mqabbla mis-sid lill-bdiewa, li qatt ma ssir "propjeta' privata" imma tibqa' tghajjat lis-Sid. U hawn l-Isqof Grech semma tliet tipi ta' "għelieqi" li s-Sid jafda lill-bniedem: (a) Il-kuxjenza, (b) Il-familja mibnija fuq iż-żwieġ u (ċ) Il-Knisja.

KOCHI- KERALA

The 21-day pilgrimage of Don Bosco Relics in Kerala seems to have created records in the number of stops made for veneration of the relics in any Indian Province to date, as well as the number of parishes and dioceses visited. During this time in fact, Don Bosco's relics had stops for veneration in 82 places in Kerala covering 12 districts and 34 dioceses. The number of Christians is not a large one, but people turned up in huge numbers far

beyond the calculations of the organisers. The cooperation of local clergy and bishops was more than anyone could have asked for. Media coverage in general and that of the Salesians was quite impressive. The local newspapers, especially the district editions and television channels, gave extensive news coverage of the pilgrimage of Don Bosco's Relics.

VARADARAJANPET

22 October 2011: Don Bosco's casket arrived in Varadarajanpet, in the Tiruchy Province. It was welcomed by youth groups in traditional dress who sang and danced in honour of Don Bosco. After saying a prayer, the relic was carried into the parish church where Bishop Antony Samy DD of Kumbakonam, presided over Mass in which 50 priests, 200 sisters and 15 thousand people took part.



CHENNAI

From the middle of October until the middle of November Don Bosco's casket was in the Indian State of Tamil Nadu. On the 13th of October after its successful visit to the State of Kerala, where

Catholics constitute an important minority (19%), Don Bosco's casket entered the Tiruchy Province at Kuthenkuzhy.

It was kept in the Tiruchy Province until the 28th of October, being taken round the Salesian houses, all of which had made special preparations and welcomed the casket with joy. On many occasions there was also a significant presence of diocesan religious authorities. For example, at Coimbatore, Mass in the Cathedral of St Michael, at which Bishop Thomas Aquinas Lephonse presided, about 60 priests concelebrated. Early in the morning of the 28th October at Yercaud, in the presence of 3,000 faithful, the Provincial of Tiruchy, Fr Albert Johnson, presided over a farewell. On the 29th October, at "Don Bosco Anbu Illam" for young people at risk and street children, the Speaker of the Legislative Assembly of Tamil Nadu, the Hon. D. Jayakumar showed his respects to the casket; and the following day at the Don Bosco Church in Ayanavaram, it was welcomed by the newly elected Mayor of Madras, the Hon. Saidai Duraisamy and the Member of Parliament the Hon N. Balaganga.

Saint John Bosco

A brief account of his life

Part 1

Throughout history, God has sent prophets and saints to warn, teach and lead His people. Modern times are no exception. God has sent saints to found religious orders of men and women for particular needs. He has sent martyrs, virgin, and holy men, such as Don Bosco, to teach virtue and apostleship to a special portion of God's people - namely youth. This is his life story.

A TROUBLED CITY

Political intrigue, assassinations, urban riots and civil wars wrecked Western Europe as it struggled to establish democratic governments during the 19th century. The continent's Christians, bitterly divided, offered feeble opposition to militant atheists.

Turin, a gracious northern Italian city, had seen better days than those of the winter of 1846. For centuries before that travelers knew Turin as the "loveliest village in the world." Many aristocratic families traced their ancestry to the days when

Roman legions had guarded Italy's northern reaches and controlled the Alpine passes through which commerce and occasionally invading armies, moved into Italy. With this magnificent scenic setting, cultured population and commercial importance, the city developed a distinct aristocratic style. In the times of which we write, the House of Savoy, royal rulers of northern Italy, held court there.

However all was not serene. Nineteenth-century Turin, like so many European cities, was changing from a quite provincial centre into a busy industrial city. As more and more factories appeared, more and more people flowed from farms and out of valleys to seek the employment and excitement offered by Turin. The recently arrived working class crowded into filthy, airless tenements, sometimes six or eight to a room. Vice, disease and crime flourished; for most slum dwellers God was a dim memory associated with the farms they had abandoned for the city. Vicious gangs of young toughs formed in the streets, leaving a trail of robberies, muggings, and occasionally murders in their wake. City fathers increased the police force and administered justice swiftly. "The loveliest village in the world," now claiming a population of 150,000 people, boasted no less



than four good-sized prisons. Many inmates were mere boys, some not yet in their teens.

THE PIED PIPER

A new problem now plagued Turin's harassed citizenry. At its root was, of all things, a slightly offbeat priest. For the past several years this cleric, known as Don Bosco, had been leading a band of singing, shouting slum boys through Turin's stylish streets. The priest, clad in battered biretta, patched cassock and peasant work shoes, had started with a handful of boys. Now the original pack had swollen into a horde numbering some 400. Although the boys had not yet committed any crime, citizens worried about Bosco's ability to control his small army.

Government authorities, newspaper editors and enemies feared that Father Bosco was laying the foundations of a future political power base. In Italy's then unstable political climate such an assumption was not unreasonable. The Italy of Father Bosco's time was divided into seven different states. Austrian and French royal houses ruled a good half of the nation. The Papal States, ruled by Pope Pius IX, straddled the nation's central portion. When Pius IX, who had no army, refused to support a war to throw out the Austrian occupiers, many Italians judged the pontiff to be a defender of foreign rulers and an opponent of national unity, thus the vast tide of anti-clericalism, which had been building for years, swept over the land.

Enemies of the Church drove bishops from their dioceses, suppressed religious houses and exiled priests, Sisters and Brothers. Pope Pius IX and the Italian clergy became the favourite whipping boys of the liberal revolutionary press. Hatred reached a boiling point when revolutionary gangs, in November 1848, broke into Pope Pius IX's Roman palace, stabbed his prime minister and fatally shot one of the Pope's staff. Pope Pius IX fled to the kingdom of Naples, where he remained in exile for six months. Due to the nature of his work and

the success he had already enjoyed with youth, John Bosco too became a favourite target. To all charges he calmly replied: "In politics I side with no one. I am a priest. The only kingdom I serve is the kingdom of God."

FROM THE AGE OF NINE

John had been yearning to serve that kingdom since he was a small boy. "At the age of nine," he wrote, "I knew I wanted to be a priest and to help young people." His father, a hardworking farmer, died when John was not yet two years old. His mother Margaret held her family together, running the small Bosco farm, raising three children, and supporting her own elderly and infirm mother-in-law. Margaret, a woman of sterling character and enormous courage, proved equal to the relentless and often bitter struggle to survive.

Although lacking money and influence, young John Bosco was not without resources. He possessed an amazing array of talents and his physical coordination was superb. At country fairs he studied the magician's tricks and the daredevil's acrobatic stunts, then back home he practiced these feats until he could imitate and often excel his mentors. John never lost his enthusiasm for this dangerous recreation. He knew that magic tricks and tightrope balancing would attract young people to him.

His physical prowess, however, pales before his mental acumen. Highly intelligent, John possessed a formidable memory. This talent came to light one evening when, during the course of a parish mission, the pastor inquired if John understood the sermon. The little boy of only nine years repeated without mistake every word the missionary had preached. Remember, this was in the day when no missionary would dare descend the pulpit unless he had spoken for at least an hour!

As John grew to young manhood he had becomes cheerful, disciplined and had a tremendous capacity for work.

Qdusija fil-Familja Salesjana *San Luigi Guanella*

Nhar il-Hadd 23 ta' Ottubru 2011, wara li kien ġie aċċertat il-miraklu ta' fejqan ta' żagħżuġ Amerikan, Willian Glisson, fl-2002, il-Papa Benedittu XVI iddikjara qaddis lill-qassis Luigi Guanella. Dan sar 96 sena wara l-mewt ta' das-saċerdot magħruf għall-karità tiegħu. B'dan tifräh il-Familja Salesjana għaliex Dun Luigi kien hađem ma' Dun Bosco għal 3 snin shaħ u minħabba l-fatt li l-hidma tiegħu bħala fundatur kienet ispirata mill-karizma edukattiv tal-Qaddis ta' Valdocco.

Dun Luigi Guanella infatti, huwa fundatur tal-Qaddejja tal-Karità (Qassin) u ta' Ulied Santa Marija tal-Providenza (Sorijiet), li huma msejġha sabiex jimxu fuq l-eżempju tal-Familja ta' Nazzařet, waqt li jgħixu ħajja qaddisa bi programm sempliċi: li titlob u "li ssofri. Dawn iż-żewġ Kongregazzjonijiet huma mxerrda fi 15-il pajjiż.

Meta kien għadu saċerdot novell kien sema' b'Dun Bosco, "il-qassis taż-żgħażaġh" u xtaq ħafna jiltaqa' miegħu. Fl-1870 mar Turin, proprju f'Valdocco fejn kien hemm l-Oratorju ta' Dun Bosco; u wara dan mar drabi oħra sabiex jiltaqa' miegħu. Dun Bosco dejjem laqgħu bil-hlewwa, sakemm ma aċċettahx bħala Salesjan.

Fl-omelija tiegħu, il-Papa qal, "Grazzi għal għaqda profonda u deġġiema ma' Kristu, u fil-kontemplazzjoni ta' mħabbtU, Dun Guanella, immexxi mill-Providenza Mqaddsa, sar is-

sieheb u l-għalliem, il-faraġ u l-qawwa tal-izjed fqar u dgħajfa. L-imħabba ta' Alla nebbħitu sabiex jagħmel l-almu tiegħu għal dawk fdati lilu, fiċ-ċirkustanzi tal-ħajja ta' kuljum... Hija l-imħabba ta' Kristu li ddawwal il-ħajja ta' kull bniedem, waqt li turina li meta nagħtu lilna nfusna lill-oħrajn ma nkunu nitilfu xejn, anzi nilhqu l-milja tal-veru ferħ."

Il-Papa mbagħad ikkonkluda, "Jalla San Luigi Guanella jaqlgħalna l-grazzja li nikbru fil-ħbiberija mal-Mulej, sabiex inġorru aħna stess, f'jiem ħajjitna, il-milja tal-imħabba ta' Alla u hekk immexxu l-ħajja lejn l-aħjar mod ta' għajxiēn u kundizzjonijiet, sabiex il-bnedmin isiru dejjem aktar veri wlied Alla."

Waqt li l-fergħat kollha tal-Kongregazzjoni Salesjana qegħdin mexjin lejn it-Tieni Ċentnarju tat-twelid ta' Dun Bosco, il-qdusija ta' San Luigi Guanella tidher bħala frott appostoliku ta' mħabba f'dik is-siġra kbira li hija l-Familja Salesjana.

THE OLD DENTED BUCKET

Our house was directly across the street from the clinic entrance of Johns Hopkins Hospital in Baltimore . We lived downstairs and rented the upstairs rooms to out-patients at the clinic. One summer evening as I was fixing supper, there was a knock at the door. I opened it to see a truly awful looking man.

“Why, he’s hardly taller than my 8-year-old,” I thought as I stared at the stooped, shriveled body. But the appalling thing was his face, lopsided from swelling, red and raw. Yet his voice was pleasant as he said, “Good evening. I’ve come to see if you’ve a room for just one night. I came for a treatment this morning from the eastern shore, and there’s no bus ‘til morning.”

He told me no one seemed to have a room. “I guess it’s my face I know it looks terrible, but my doctor says with a few more treatments .. I could sleep in this rocking chair on the porch. My bus leaves early in the morning.”

I told him we would find him a bed. I went inside and finished getting supper. When we were ready, I asked the old man if he would join us. “No, thank you. I have plenty.” And he held up a brown paper bag.

I went out on the porch to talk with him a few minutes. It didn’t take a long time to see that this old man had an oversized heart crowded into that tiny body. He told me he fished for a living

to support his daughter, her 5 children, and her husband, who was hopelessly crippled from a back injury. He didn’t tell it by way of complaint; in fact, every other sentence was prefaced with a thanks to God for a blessing. He was grateful that no pain accompanied his disease, which was apparently a form of skin cancer. He thanked God for giving him the strength to keep going...

At bedtime, we put a camp cot in the children’s room for him. When I got up in the morning, the bed linens were neatly folded and the little man was out on the porch. He refused breakfast, but just before he left for his bus, haltingly, as if asking a great favour, he said, “Could I please come back and stay the next time I have a treatment?” He paused a moment and then added, “Your children made me feel at home. Grownups are bothered by my face, but children don’t seem to mind.” I told him he was welcome to come again.

And, on his next trip, he arrived a little after 7 in the morning. As a gift, he brought a big fish and a quart of the largest oysters I had ever seen! I knew his bus left at 4:00 a.m. And I wondered what time he had to get up in order to do this for us.

In the years he came to stay overnight with us, there was never a time that he did not bring us fish or oysters or vegetables from his garden. Other times we received packages in the mail, always by special delivery; fish and oysters packed in a box of fresh young spinach or kale, every leaf carefully washed. Knowing that he must walk 3 miles to mail these, and knowing how little money he had, made the gifts doubly precious.

I know our family always will be grateful to have known him; from him we learned what it was to accept the bad without complaint and the good with gratitude to God.

Recently I was visiting a friend, who has a greenhouse, as she showed me her flowers, we came to the most beautiful one of all, a golden chrysanthemum, bursting with blooms. But to my great surprise, it was growing in an old dented, rusty bucket. I thought to myself, "If this were my plant, I'd put it in the loveliest container I had!" My friend changed my mind. "I ran short of pots," she explained, "and knowing how beautiful this one would be, I thought it wouldn't mind starting out in this old pail. It's just for a little while, till I can put it out in the garden."

She must have wondered why I laughed so delightedly, but I was imagining just such a scene in heaven. "Here's an especially beautiful one," God might have said when he came to the soul of the sweet old fisherman. "He won't mind starting in this small body." All this happened long ago - and now, in God's garden, how tall this lovely soul must stand.

The LORD does not look at the things man looks at. Man looks at the outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart." (1 Samuel 16:7b)





St. Francis de Sales

24th January

Bishop and Gentle Pastor of Souls

Francis was born in 1567 in the castle belonging to the Sales family in Thorens, Savoy, south-eastern France. He studied in Paris and Padua. During his student days in Paris he experienced a great spiritual crisis. He cried out to God in desperation and vowed his love for God, placed his hope in his mercy and promised to praise him always. In the depths of his anguish he went to the church of Our Lady of Kind Deliverance and promised he would recite the rosary every day. At that moment his eyes fell on a card bearing the Memorare of St. Bernard. He recited the prayer and experienced a complete transformation. A great peace came over him - he was healed. This profound experience of God's unconditional love was the bedrock for all his future theological studies and writings. The gospel came alive for him - Jesus came not to condemn, but as his Saviour.

THE RESPONSE OF LOVE

Francis understood the essence of human freedom. The great choice facing every human being is the freedom to respond or not to respond to God's love. He followed God's call to priesthood, was ordained at the age of twenty-five and consecrated Bishop of Geneva at the age of thirty-five. He lived in Annecy until his death twenty years later. Francis took seriously the call

of the Council of Trent to restore the unity and vitality of the faith. When he became bishop, he took care that all priests in his diocese were well formed spiritually. He encouraged his priests to study 'everything good'. He believed that learning for a priest was the 'eighth sacrament of the Church'. He always encouraged gentleness and compassion.

'LIVE JESUS'

Shortly after becoming bishop, Francis met Jane de Chantal, a young mother recently widowed. He became her spiritual director. Between these two saints there grew a deep spiritual friendship. All their correspondence had engraved on it the motto 'Live Jesus'. To allow Jesus to live was the very heart of their friendship and the love of God, revealed in him, pervaded every line of their letters. Together they gave shape to the new spiritual family of the Visitation Sisters. Francis and Jane show us clearly that the deepest intimacy among people is an intimacy that finds its origin and its goal in God who gave people to each other to be incarnate signs of his divine love.

Francis saw humanity as the vessel which could contain the miracle of divine life. The human person had the most compelling vocation - to realize his or her fullest capacity for the love

of God. This love, Francis said, has 'two arms - one is the love of God in prayer; the other is the love of God known by loving care for others'. His *Introduction to the Devout Life* provides practical direction for building up the whole community, giving encouragement to the laity to develop a life of prayer and love that would animate the whole body of Christ. He encouraged the practice of 'little virtues'. 'Let us belong to God in the midst of much busyness'. It is in the midst of the world, that God has planted the worker, housewife, student and parent.

CHRIST IN THE HEART

In all his direction of souls, Francis stressed the centrality of the heart as the place of conversion and transformation. There we can gently return to God, curbing the impatient, angry retort and responding with gentleness, humility and simplicity. As we 'learn Christ' and are conformed to him, he lives in us and so is radiated with love to the world. When Jesus is written in the heart it will produce actions bearing the stamp of the sacred name.

Francis loved the Church. He was acutely aware of the spiritual turmoil, laxity and erroneous theological views that prevailed in his day. This did not blind him to the Church's heavenly origins. Rather, it spurred him to work for renewal. To Jane he wrote: "Next to the love of God, I commend to you love of his Bride, the Church. Have compassion for all pastors and preachers in the Church... Pray for them so that they may obtain the salvation of souls at the same time that they are saving themselves."



A SURE GUIDE TO HEAVEN

When Francis died in 1622, aged fifty-five he left behind many theological works, a vast range of correspondence, a renewed diocese, a new religious order, and men and women in every walk of life dedicated to holiness of life. The holiness that Francis presents is attractive to 'little souls' - one comes to God in prayer without anxiety, with peace and humility. Because of his writings, he became patron of writers and journalists. His *Introduction to the Devout Life* was a best-seller and his *Treatise on the Love of God* is a spiritual classic. He was canonised in 1665 and declared a Doctor of the Church in 1877.

St. John Bosco chose him as a Model, Titular (Salesians) and Patron Saint of the Salesian Congregation.

Il-Madonna fl-arti, fil-mużika u fil-poeżija *minn John Bisazza*

Il-fidi mhix fatt razzjonali biss iżda teħtieġ anki espressjonijiet li jstimulaw id-devozzjoni. F'artiklu qasir huwa impossibbli li wieħed isemmi l-opri kollha tal-arti, mużika u poeżija li nholqu biex ifaħħru lil-Marija.

Marija hija krejatura privileġġjata li ilha tiġi meqjuma mill-Insara mill-ewwel snin tal-kristjaneżmu. Fil-katakombi ta' Priscilla tat-tieni seklju ġewwa Ruma jinsabu mnaqqxa mal-hitant graffiti tal-Madonna magħmula mill-ewwel Insara li juru kemm kienu riedu jigglorifikaw il-kobor tagħha. Imxerrda mad-dinja insibu bosta ikoni ewlenin fosthom il-Madonna s-Sewda ġewwa l-Polonja u l-famuża Salus Populi Romani fil-Bażilka majestuża ta' Santa Maria Maggiore ġewwa Ruma, mibnija mill-Papa Liberius. Insibu wkoll numru sewwa fit-Turkija, u f'Malta nsibu l-ikona tal-Madonna tal-Mellieħa li jingħad li ġiet impittra min San Luqa, u l-Madonna ta' Caraffa li tinsab fil-konkattedral ta' San Ġwann. Bejn il-ħames u s-sitt seklju l-ikoni Marjani xterrdu mal-knejjes Insara kollha. Kienu l-ewwel għamla ta' xbihat reliġjużi. Wara l-Konċilju ta' Efesu tas-sena 431 meta Marija ġiet pproklamata **Omm Alla - Theotokos** l-incidenta tal-ikoni Marjani kibret sew, l-iżjed fil-knejjes tal-Lvant.

Mal-medda tas-snin, fil-knejjes bdew jidhru pitturi u mużajċi ta' Marija li bdew jagħtu wiċċ ġdid lill-ikonografija reliġjuża fil-knejjes Kattolici, speċjalment dawk tal-Ewropa tal-punent. Il-miġja tal-perjodu rinaxximentali, bejn is-sekli erbatax u sbatax, wassal għall-introduzzjoni ta' żmien

artistiku u kulturali li influwenza mhux f'it, l-arti figurattiva, letterarja u mużikali. Kien f'dawn is-snin li bdiet tintuża l-arkitektura barokka u neoklassika, l-iżjed fl-Italja u Spanja. Dawn kienu mimlija movimenti, kuluri u trijonfalizmu li bdew jiehdu post dak romanesk u gotiku. Ma setax jonqos li madwar l-Ewropa, inkluż f'pajjiġna, l-arkitektura u l-arti barokka effettwaw il-viżjoni ta' diversi kategoriji ta' pitturi li warrbu l-istil sobriju tal-ikoni u bdew juru lill-Madonna f'għamla iżjed ħajja u movimentata. Il-korrelazzjoni bejn l-arti, il-mużika u l-poeżija bdew jissawru b'rata mghaġġla f'immensità ta' ħsibijiet li permezz tagħhom żejnu u gglorifikaw l-eċċellenza ta' Marija.

Ma nahsibx li nkun qed niżbalja jekk ngħid li l-ewwel evidenza ta' tifhir bil-fomm sar minn Marija stess meta ltaqgħet ma' Eliġabetta, permezz tal-Kantiku ta' Marija - **Il Magnificat** - innu li jissemma fil-Vangelu ta' San Luqa (1:46-55) u li fil-Katekiżmu tal-Knisja Kattolika huwa deskritt bħala l-Innu ta' Omm Alla.

Fl-ewwel tmien mitt sena tal-era Kristjana feġġew bosta kitbiet li żviluppaw f'innijiet; ta' min isemmi fosthom **Stabat Mater** fis-sena 930 minn Pietro di Compastella u **Salve Regina** tas-sena 1080 aktarx miktuba minn San Anselmu min Lucca.



Żewġ innijiet antiki hafna huma **Ave Maris Stella** tas-seklu tmienja attribwit lil-Pawlu d-Djaknu u li jinsab fil-kodiċi tal-monasteru ta' San Gallo u **Alma Redemptoris Mater** miktub fil-hdax-il seklu minn Hermann ta' Reichenau. L-istrofi tal-aħħar tnejn jiġbru fihom it-tagħlim teoloġiku essenzjali dwar Marija.

Sas-snin tan-nofs (bejn is-sekli erbatax u sbatax) id-devozzjoni lejn Marija tant kibret li għet irregjistrata żieda konsiderevoli ta' kompożizzjonijiet letterarji u ta' arti viżiva b'tema Marjana. Wieħed mill-isbaħ u l-aqwa xogħlijiet letterarji huwa l-*kapolavur* ta' Dante Alighieri **La Divina Commedia** li fiha niseġ l-isbaħ tifhir lill-Vergni Marija u li f'l-1898 Giuseppe Verdi silet minna l-lirika tat-tielet Canto u mmużikah taħt l-isem ta' **Laudi alla Vergine Maria**. Ma jistgħux jiġu rregjistrati l-ismijiet ta' dawk kollha li kitbu, ikkomponew mużika, jew holqu opri ta' pittura u skultura f'għieħ dik li Alla għażel għat-tjubija, l-umiltà u s-safa tagħha, f'artiklu wieħed; imma ma nistax ma nsemmix ġenji kbar bħal pitturi Botticelli, Giotto, Masaccio mingħajr ma nħalli barra lil Michelangelo - pittur u skultur ta' ġenju - li mingħajr dubju waħda mill-isbaħ opri tiegħu hija **La Pietà** ġewwa l-Bażilika ta' San Pietru.

Fis-sekli dsatax u għoxrin ġew definiti d-dommi

l-kbar ta' **Marija Imwielda Mingħajr Tebgha** (Piju IX 8/12/1854 -Ineffabilis Deus) u **Marija Imtella' s-Sema bir-Ruħ u l-Ġisem** (Piju XII (1/11/1950 - Munificentissimus Deus) żewġ ġrajjet li komplew jagħtu għarfien lill-kobar ta' Marija. Kienu s-sekli ta' l-apparizzjonijiet ta' Marija ġewwa Lourdes (1858) u **Fatima** (1918). Matul dawn is-sekli nsibu bosta xogħlijiet ta' mużiċisti li kkonfermaw li l-venerazzjoni lejn il-Madonna kellha post prominenti fil-hajja artistika tagħhom - żvilupp li influwenza numru ta' kompożituri Maltin, fosthom Antonio u Paolo Nani, Riccardo u Vincenzo Buġeja, Carlo Diacono, Giuseppe Caruana u Ferdinando Camilleri (1859-1942) - il-kompożitur tal-antifona **Stella Maris** - u ibnu Giuseppe (1903-1976). Dan Giuseppe wiret il-ġenju mużikali ta' missieru u ma naqasx li juża t-talenti tiegħu biex ifaħħar lill-Marija permezz tal-mużika - fost l-oħrajn ikkompona l-innu **Lil Marija Kewkba tal-Baħar** fuq il-kliem tal-poeta Dun Pietru Pawl Grima.

Kienu bosta l-kittieba u poeti Maltin li faħħru lil-Marija bl-isbaħ kliem ispirati minn devozzjoni u qima, ewlenin fosthom, Rużar Briffa, Luigi Billion, Patri Anastasio Cuschieri, magħruf bħala l-poeta tal-Madonna, Patri Ġużepp Delia SJ, Dun Pietru Pawl Grima, Patri Marjanu Vella OFM, u l-poeta nazzjonali Dun Karm Psaila li l-ewwel poeżija

tiegħu bil-Malti, li kiteb fil-11 ta' Jannar tal-1912, kienet **'Quddiem Xbiha tal-Madonna'** u li kienet il-bidu ta' xeħta poetika b'ispirazzjoni Marjana li baqgħet kostanti tul ħajtu kollha. Insemmi, mela, tlieta mill-isbaħ innijiet Marjani tiegħu **'Ismagħha l-Għanja'**, **'Fil-Hlewwa ta' Mejju'** u **'O Kemm Nixtieq Naraha'**.

Bejn nofs is-seklu tmintax u matul is-sekli dsatax u ghoxrin pitturi Maltin u barranin ħolqu xogħlijiet sagri tassew ta' livell għoli; fost dawn insibu lil Francesco Zahra, Lazzaro Pisani, Giuseppe Cali, Emvin Cremona u t-Taljani Virgilio Monti, Stefano Erardi, Alessio Erardi, u Pietro Gagliardi li taw għieh lil Marija permezz tat-talenti tagħhom. It-Taljan Mario Caffaro Rore, bejn is-snin 1956 u 1959, halla tnax-il pittura fuq diversi episodi tal-ħajja ta' Marija fil-Knisja ta' Stella Maris, f'Tas-Sliema. Ta' ċertu preġju artistiku huma, hawnhekk, il-kwadru titular, impinġi fl-1583 u li oriġinalment kien jinsab fil-Knisja ta' Porto Salvo fil-belt Valletta u li jista' jkun li huwa ta' Filippo Paladini, il-pittura tal-abside fil-kor, xogħol ta' Giuseppe Cali' tal-1887, u mingħajr dubju il-vara titulari maħduma fi Franza fl-1891 li timortalizza id-devozzjoni u l-arti flimkien.

L-istess għamlu l-istatwarji ta' Carlo Darmanin, Marjanu Ġerada u Agostino Camilleri li, imnebbħa

minn influwenza Ewropeja tal-punent, ħadmu ħafna statwi tal-Madonna li jinsabu imxerrdin fil-knejjes tagħna.

F'Malta nsibu tnejn u tletin parroċċa, u sitta f'Għawdex, minbarra numru ta' kappelli, kollha ddedikati lill-Madonna. Fit-toroq tal-ibliet u l-irħula tagħna ma jonqsux numru ta' niceċ iddedikati lil-Marija. Dan juri li d-devozzjoni lejn Marija kellha u għad għandha għeruoq sodi fil-gzejjer Maltin.

F'Għeluq il-mitt sena mid-Domma tal-Immakulata il-poeta u drammaturgu Vincenzo Maria Pellegrini (1911-1997) kiteb l-Azzjoni Marjana bit-Taljan **'La Predestinata'** li fiha sawwar l-avvenimenti l-iktar qaddisa fil-ħajja tal-Madonna u li fi kliemu stess 'insigt l-isbaħ innu li qatt ħareġ mill-pinna tiegħi'. Kienu ħafna dawk id-drabi meta l-kliem tal-poeti ġew addattati għal-mużika u ssawru f'innijiet; eżempju ta' dan hija silta mill-innu ta' Dun Karm Psaila **'Ismagħha l-Għanja'**, li tirrifletti r-rabta bejn Marija u pajjiżna -

"F'kull naħa mwarra ta' l-Gżira tagħna, hemm l-isem tiegħek fil-blat miktub, Tidhaq xbiehetek fil-Knisja kollha, fejn tqimek dejjem l-għanja tal-qlub."

Li kienet mara oħra aktarx li tibda twerżaq u tibki għall-għajjut, imma Margot ta' bniedma bilanċjata li kienet ippruvat iżżomm il-kalma. Kienet taf sew li bit-twerżiq ma kienet ser takkwista xejn, ma ssołvi xejn hliet li tpxax xi ġirien li dejjem jagħtuha l-impressjoni li mohħhom fiha.

Nehhiet il-fardal minn madwarha. Resqet quddiem il-mera antika fl-intrata tad-dar kbira u lussuża tagħha. Melset f'tit xagħarha biex tqiegħdu f'postu. Kienet ser tirroranġa d-dehra ta' wiċċha meta ftakret f'xi haġ'ohra li f'dawk ċ-ċirkustanzi kienet ta' akbar hteġa mid-dehra ta' wiċċha - kella issir malajr, qabel ma jiġu l-pulizija.

Bil-heffa telgħet it-taraġ. Mingħajr ma ntebħet x'qed tagħmel habtet fuq il-bieb ta' Mr. Parker, jew aħjar ta' Ernest kif drat issejjaħlu. Mingħajr ma stenniet tweġiba dahlet fil-kamra. Skantat bil-kuraġġ li hasset. Ma stkerrhitx, ma warrbitx ħarsitha minn fuq is-sodda fejn kien stendut il-mejjet. Resqet lejn l-iskrivanija. B'id

tirtgħod ġabret ittra qasira li kien kiteb. Tat daqqa t'għajn ħafifa lejn il-bidu tal-ittra. Kienet tgħid hekk: "Għażiża Alice ..."

Ma kellhiex hin taqra aktar, imma l-isem ta' 'Alice' stona f'tit f'mohħha. Qrat l-indirizz ta' fuq l-envelop: "Mrs. A.Parker, Parker Lodge, 3,Throgmorton Avenue, London, EC 2" Ma kienx l-indirizz tiegħu tas-soltu. Jista' jkun li kien kiteb lil ommu, imma ommu għadha ħajja? Intant, ħatfet l-ittra u l-envelop minn hemm u hbiethom għax hi rraġunat li ittri personali ma kellhomx jaqgħu f'idejn il-pulizija. F'għajnejn Margot, pulizija qatt ma jista' jkun bniedem b'qalb ta' bnedmin oħra; dawk kienu razza ta' nies għalihom. Fil-hin indunat li waslet il-karozza tal-pulizija quddiem id-dar tagħha.

Ma damux hemm. F'tit mistoqsijiet ta' rutina u li għalihom wiegħbet bla tlaqliq. Imbagħad ċemplu lill-maġistrat li kien għassa u lil dawk li kellhom jieħdu lil Ernest għall-awtopsja.

Filgħaxija xħin marret issaqsi biex tkun taf ir-riżultat qalulha li Ernest kien tah attakk kbir tal-qalb. Kella tieħu ħsieb tibgħat tgħid lill-familja tiegħu. L-ewwel ħsieb tagħha kien li tikkuntattja lil Mark, iben Ernest. Hsabet li jkun aħjar jekk tagħmel hekk u wara tqabbad lilu stess jagħti l-aħjar lil ommu.

Kos, kemm taf tkun stramba l-ħajja! Kien l-ewwel darba li Ernest ġie waħdu mingħajr martu Mavis li

dejjem kienet tieġu ħsiebu. Margot ftakret li għaddiet xi rimarka meta ratu waġdu, imma dak il-ħin Ernest qisu pprova jaqtgħalha fil-qasir. Kienet drathom jiġu hemm għandha dawk l-aħħar ħames snin, jiġu kull tliet xhur. Kienet tgħodd il-jiem li jkun fadal biex jasl u għax draw sew 'il xulxin u tqishom aktar bħala ħbieb milli dawk li jikru minn għandha biex iqallgħuha xi sold. Issa li miet Ernest aktarx jispicċa kollox, Mavis ma tiġix weħidha għax mhux li tgħid li kellha xi ħajra speċjali għal Malta.

Margot għamlet f'it tal-kuraġġ biex teħles minn dik it-telefonata lil Mark. Wegħbitha mara li lehinha ma għarfitx. Staqsiet għal Mark waqt li bdiet tieġu f'it tar-ruħ xhin semgħet leħnu. Mill-aħjar li setgħet bdiet ittarrafu xi haġa u ftehemu li l-għada filgħodu kellu jiġi Malta flimkien ma' ommu.

Raqdet tard u qamet kmieni u fit-tmienja kienet ġa qed tistenna l-ajruport. Minn ħin għall-ieħor beda jaqbzilha d-dmugħ xhin tiftakar f'dak li nqala' ġewwa darha stess, u l-fatt li miet waġdu mingħajr lanqas biss ma lahaq sejhilha. Il-jum ta' qabel ma setgħetx tibki, u issa ma setgħetx twaqqaf id-dmugħ. Kif kienet ser tikkonsla lil Mavis?

L-ajruplan wasal fil-ħin u bdew herġin il-passiġġieri. Għajnejha mill-ewwel lemħu lil Mark. Imma lil Mavis ma setgħet taraha b'xejn. Qrib Mark kien hemm mara oħra, forsi t-tfajla tiegħu. Fl-aħħar mill-kuratur tal-passiġġieri bdew herġin in-nies, rat lil Mark u ... le, dik li kienet miegħu mhix tfajla ... kienet mara kbira f'it fiż-żmien, liebsa skur. Harsu lejn Margot mill-bogħod u tbissmulha. Margot bdiet titħawwad ġmielha. U Mavis fejnha, għala ma ġietx? Kien hemm xi haġa li ħassitha li mhix qed tifhem, bdiet tinfixel. Fl-istess ħin tat pass 'il quddiem biex tmur tilqagħhom.

Mark kien l-ewwel li ħadilha b'idha u waqt li għamel hekk dawwar driegħu x-xellugija ma' dahar dik il-mara

tal-libsja blu. Ta ħarsa li tffisser ħafna lil Margot waqt li qallha: "Margot, din il-mamà!" Il-mara tal-libsja blu wiegħbet: "Jisimni Alice ..." Margot bisitha. Bisitha bla heġġa. Ma kenitx tafha, imma ħasset li hekk suppost li tagħmel f'ċirkustanza bħal dik. Margot bdiet tipprova tagħmel ta' bir-ruħha li ma ġara xejn stramb, li hi kienet qed tistennieha sitwazzjoni bħal dik. Fl-istess ħin ħassitha qisha qed tirreċta parti ta' xi dramma, tagħmel kull mossa u tgħid kull kelma għax hekk suppost trid tagħmel. Ma ħassithiex li kienet sinciera, imma kellha xi tort?

Marru l-isptar u wara dritt id-dar. Il-konversazzjoni kienet għadha mġebbda, formali, artifiċjali. Imma Margot insistiet li kien jinhtiegħ li jieklu xi haġa ħafifa. Kienu madwar il-mejda xhin Margot għal għarrieda ftakret fl-ittra. Marret iġġibha mill-kexxun fejn bil-għaġla kienet ħbietha qabel ma waslu l-pulizija. Tatha lil Alice waqt li spjegat kif waslet għandha.

Alice deheret li nħasdet. Waqfet mill-ikel u bdiet taqra. Għajnejha bdew jintlew bid-dmugħ u għalhekk Margot bi skuza li kien jonqos xi haġa fuq il-mejda warbet mill-kamra. Imma ma damitx weħidha fil-kamra tal-kċina għax rat lil Alice sejra ħdejjha bl-ittra f'idejha. Alice ippruvat tkellimha, imma l-kliem ma setax joħroġ minn fommha. Fl-aħħar tat l-ittra f'idejn Margot biex taqraha hi. Ittra qasira. Kienet tgħid hekk: "Għaziża Alice, nittama li mhux tard wisq. Qed naħseb fik spiss. Aħfirli. Inħobbok aktar milli qatt ħabbejtek qabel. Ninsab waġdi. Nixtieqek ħdejjha. Ċempilli u ddux. Żewġek Ernest".

Iż-żewġ nisa harsu lejn xulxin. Alice għannqet lil Margot waqt li nfexxet f'biekja ta' niket u konsolazzjoni mħalltin flimkien. Dawk iż-żewġ nisa kien ilhom jafu 'l xulxin biss għal f'it sigħat, imma setgħu jifhemu sew x'qed iħossu t-tnejn. Għalkemm kienu qed ihejju għall- funeral, dik id-daqqejn ta' ittra għabet magħha qawmien setgħan ta' mħabba li lanqas il-mewt ma tista' xxejjen.

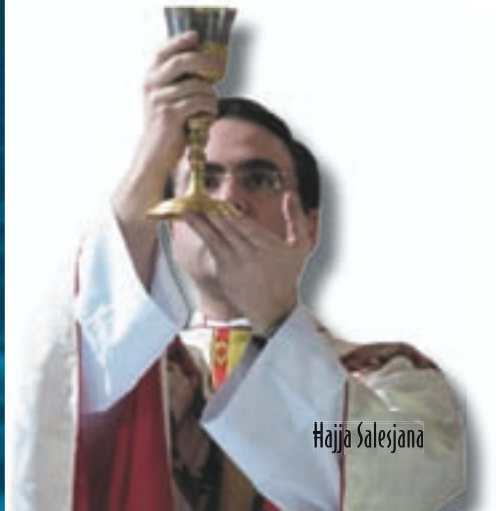
